I hereby declare that I have had the opportunity to read and that I understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU standing regulations and agree to be bound by them together with such supplementary regulations as have been or may be issued for the event.

I further declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and am competent to do so.

I confirm that I understand the nature and type of event I am entering and its inherent risks and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers/officials.

I confirm that the machine on which I enter and compete on should be suitable and proper for its purpose and that it will comply with the regulations in respect thereof and is described below. I confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine described below shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent, and that it will comply with regulations in respect thereof.

I agree that I am required to register my arrival by "signing on" at the designated place not less than 30 minutes prior to commencement of the start of the competition.

**Acknowledgement of the risk of motorsport:** I understand that by taking part in this event I am exposed to risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the ACU, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on behalf were to a contributory cause of any serious injury I may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity.

I have read the above and acknowledge that my participation in motorsport is entirely at my own risk.

I understand that before competing in this event, I must wear an identity disc giving my full name and address and date of birth. (Including your Blood Group is recommended)
